### What is a Key holder?



A monitored security or fire system always requires a key holder to respond with emergency personnel to any alarm dispatches. You should always have at least three contacts who live relatively close to your premise and are usually available if an emergency arises. This responsibility should not be taken lightly. The key holder is your representative in a potential emergency situation. Please advise your key holder not to enter the premise until emergency personnel are on the scene. The monitoring station always advises the

emergency service that a key holder is attending so they will be expecting them.

Some people have non-monitored (local) systems and they ask their neighbours to check out the premise if they hear a siren. Although this reduces the chance of false alarms and saves them monitoring charges it is not usually recognized by insurance companies for a discount. It could actually be potentially dangerous for your neighbour as well. Would you really want to ask your neighbour to enter your premise if an intruder is inside when there are no police responding and no one else knows an alarm has been triggered?

## Do you know anyone who's "Home Alone"?

Most seniors and persons with medical conditions or physical challenges would prefer to live in their own homes and be as independent as they can. This can be made possible with the addition of a Huronia Alarm & Fire Security medical alert system.

A system can be installed in minutes. It connects to your home telephone line and automatically places a call for help whenever you need assistance, any time of the day or night. Family, neighbors, or anyone whom you pre-designate can be notified immediately, so they can respond. If you already have an alarm system, a medical alert pendant can be added to your system with no extra monitoring charges.

Help is only a button push away. You keep a wireless pendant with you at all times when you are in your home. In the event of an at-home emergency you press the pendant alarm button to signal the system to automatically call our own local Monitoring station, staffed by trained professionals 24 hours a day. When these operators receive your automatic emergency call, they notify the key people whom you pre-selected to respond.

Our newest systems include a very versatile personal emergency transmitter. A number of accessories make it easy to adapt to different circumstances. These can include a wristband, a pocket/belt clip, and a pendant string. The transmitter can be completely waterproof, so you can even wear it in the shower. And it can tell you when a transmission has been sent to the console through a red indicator light on the pendant and a beep.

The long transmission range ensures that wherever you are in your home you can depend on its signal to

reach the console. The transmitter is also continuously monitored by the console, alerting you when its long life batteries get low.

Our newest Medical Alert Systems come equipped with:

- A tabletop, nightstand or wall mounted console
- Emergency button is waterproof and totally adaptable into a pendant, wristband or belt clip
- Large "Emergency" button on console
- Braille characters for all functions.
- Inactivity monitoring selectable between 8, 12 or 24 hours
