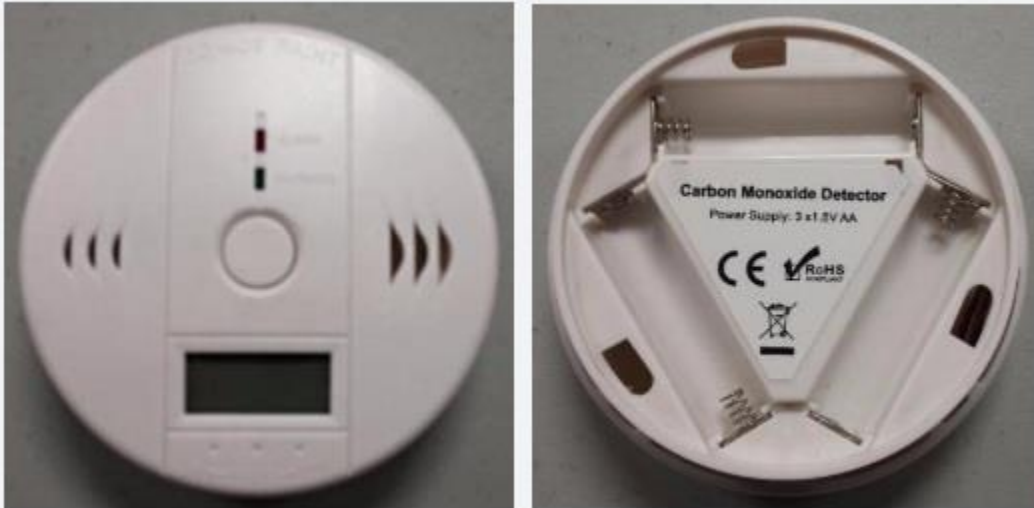

ILLEGAL CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS

For your safety, please take a moment to review the photos of these illegal carbon monoxide detectors that are being advertised and sold online (Kijiji).



These particular carbon monoxide detectors do NOT have any CSA or UL approvals which would normally be indicated by a stamp or marking on the back of the devices. As a result, these detectors are illegal and deemed unsafe for use.

All [carbon monoxide alarms](#) approved for use in Canada must meet the requirements of CSA-6.19 or UL2034. All legitimate alarm devices will have both CSA and UL approvals stamped or printed directly on the device.
