A YEAR IN REVIEW ...

2018 was another busy year for our company. As I reflect on everything that's happened, I am grateful for the ongoing support, determination and commitment to our customers that our entire team exhibited this year. We continue to excel because of these combined efforts, hard work and a rock-solid strategic plan that sees continued growth through customer loyalty and acquisitions.

This year we acquired two local companies; [Ontario Security Systems](#) based in Orillia and Canadian Security Alarms based in Barrie. As part of the Canadian Security Alarms acquisition, brothers Kolin Lee (owner of CSA) and Kris Lee have joined our security team, working primarily out of our Collingwood location.

On the technology front, we made an investment in new monitoring station software. We also integrated our accounting software so all branches are using the same software, that will bring greater efficiencies across the company, but more importantly, greater efficiencies for our customers.

Our ULC listed Monitoring Stations in Midland & Muskoka once again achieved [5-Diamond Certification from The Monitoring Association](#). This certification confirms that our station operators are proficient and excel at communications with customers, law enforcement agencies and fire and emergency services communication centers.

We also continue to be a member in good standing with the [Canadian Security Association's Accredited Security Contractor Program](#). This is a program that outlines best practices for electronic security companies to follow. There are only a handful of security companies in Canada that have achieved this accreditation, and I am proud that we continue to maintain this designation year after year.

Because of all these accomplishments, and growing our Customer base, we are able to continue to support the communities in which we do business. We do this through corporate financial donations, and also with in-kind donations and time-commitments to various community events. I am humbled by the generous spirit of the employees at Huronia who go above and beyond to support local charities that are close to their hearts. Some highlights of the year include:
