## Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre

In our <u>September enewsletter</u> we alerted you to the ongoing Canada Revenue Agency Scam. This month, we'd like to draw your attention to a new online and text-based scam that involves scammers pretending to be part of a <u>mystery shopper program</u>. While some of these mystery shopper scams originate overseas, there is an increasing number that are being carried out locally. Scammers are portraying big name retailers like Shopper's Drug Mart in an attempt to appear like a genuine job opportunity. **There are legitimate mystery shopper companies**. These companies will not charge an application fee and will accept applications online through legitimate company websites. No legitimate mystery/secret shopper program will send payment in advance and ask the employee to send a portion of it back. **Protect yourself. Be informed.** If you, or someone you know has been the victim of such a scam, contact the <u>Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre.</u>
