Members of the Southern Georgian Bay Detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were dispatched to two break and enter occurrences from mid-July to mid-August 2019 on Levi Simon Trail Penetanguishene. The OPP would like to take this opportunity to remind property owners to practice "Lock It or Lose It" as an effective way to help prevent residential type thefts. Break ins can be prevented by locking your home and utilizing better lighting where the vehicles are parked and exterior doorways.
